Buy and Burn Local Firewood

Moving firewood long distances can spread invasive insects and diseases that threaten the health and beauty of California's forests.

How you can help:

- Buy and burn your wood in the same county or region where it was cut
- Transport wood less than 50 miles from its origin
- When you camp, leave firewood at home and buy or collect firewood where you camp

Your firewood could be carrying dangerous hitchhikers! But *you* can stop them. Invasive species such as the emerald ash borer, which has killed hundreds of thousands of ash trees in the eastern United States, was stopped from entering California on firewood at an agricultural border station.
